the guide map.



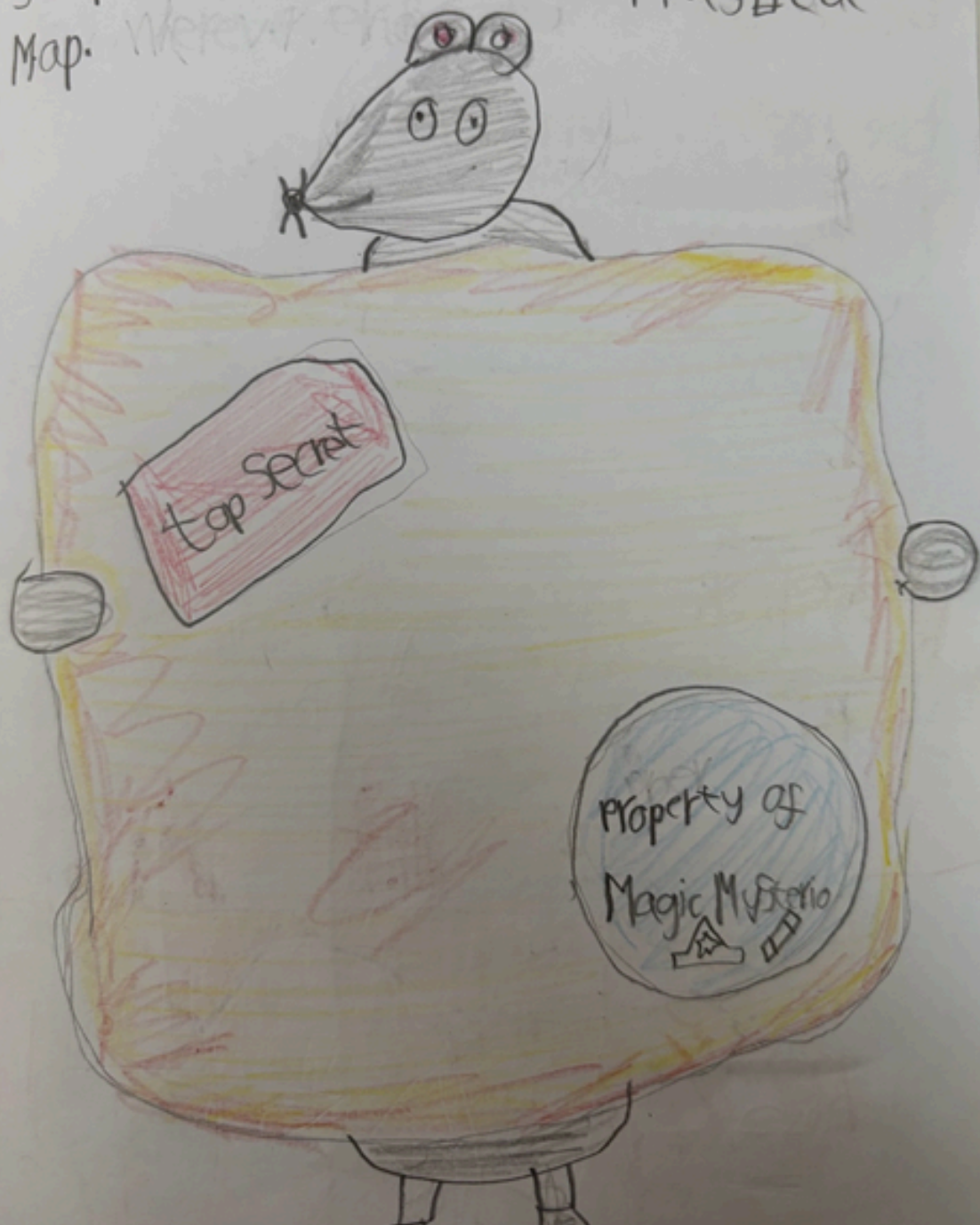
He opened the door and it
led to a secret passageway



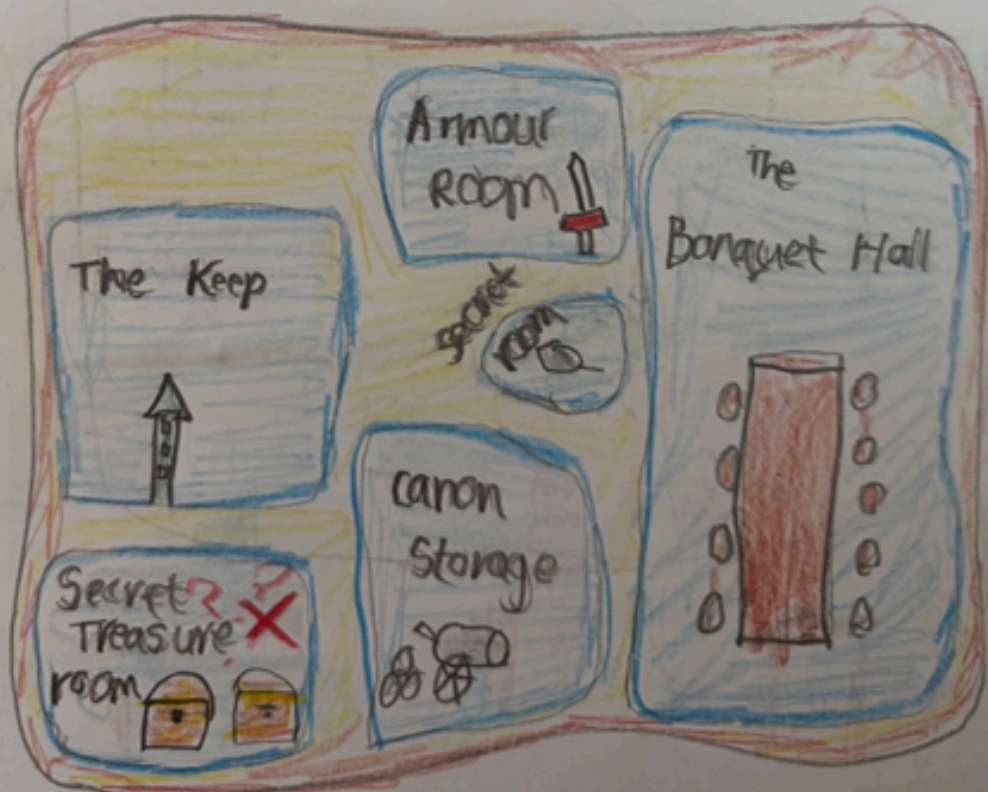
The Passage way looked long,

Map.




The Map Showed every room there was in the castle, but the most surprising thing happened when he touched a room name.
